Beaded Bead Trio – Francie Broadie Skill Level – Advanced - Class Size - 15 Kit Fee - \$28 – Class Fee - \$40 Total Cost \$68



One of the most satisfying bead projects is to make a bead out of a pile of beads. In this class, you will learn 3 different beaded beads. They can be stacked together in a pendant, or turned into earrings or a bracelet. Kits will contain enough beads to make 2 beads of each style. Several colorways will be available. Tools required: Beading surface, scissors, 6lb Fireline, size 12 beading needles, magnification if required.

Beaded 8 Cord Kumihimo Bracelet with 4 color Diamonds – Joyce Von Lienen Skill Level – Intermediate – Class Size – 6 Kit Fee - \$25 – Class Fee - \$40 Total Cost - \$65



This is a unique class where you will learn to weave strands of beads by dropping 1 bead into place with each movement. This bracelet uses 5 colors of size 8 seed beads.

This is accomplished by stringing beads onto multiple thread bobbins and loading the bobbins onto a bead loom (usually a shaped foam disk loom) before starting the weaving process.

Kits will include beads, thread for weaving - C-Lon or S-Lon stringing cord, findings and wire.

(Looms and bobbins will be available for purchase at an additional cost (approximately \$10), but will only be provided with advance notice.)

Tools required: Kumihimo disk loom and bobbins (available at Hobby Lobby), bead mat, scissors, Fray Check, and magnification if needed.

Desert Dreaming Bracelet – Vicki Hoffman Skill Level = All Levels - Class Size - 10 Kit Fee - \$55 – Class Fee - \$40 Total Cost - \$95



Enjoy weaving this charming brick stitch charm bracelet. A refresher for some, a new basic stitch for others. The bracelet works up quickly using two colors, turquoise seed beads in blue or green and coral red and uses both size 8 and 11 seed beads. When finished, this bracelet is a classic addition to your jewelry wardrobe!

Kits include slices of genuine turquoise from the Kingman Mine located in Kingman, AZ, along with southwest style charms to add to the top of the turquoise slices. Additionally, you will receive a .999 fine silver button charm created by the instructor to incorporate into your bracelet.

Tools required: Size 10/12 beading needles, 6lb Fireline (smoke color), scissors, bead mat, optional light and magnification as needed.

Tears of Autumn Pendant and Earrings will be a fabulous addition to your fall jewelry collection! This is a simple but elegant pairing and will be available in 2 colorways.

Learn the basics of bead embroidery, including back stitch, edging and how to add a drop finding. You will be a pro after completing this project!

Tools required: Bead mat, scissors, 6lb Fireline, size 12 beading needles, magnification if required.

Pondo Stitch Bracelet – Francie Broadie Skill Level – Intermediate – Class Size - 15 Kit Fee - \$30 – Class Fee - \$40 Total Cost - \$70



Are you itching to learn something new? Come give Pondo stitch a try. It's a little like right-angle weave, but not quite.

This project works up quickly using larger beads. Drops will be available for purchase if you want to further embellish your bracelet. Kits will be available in multiple colorways.

Tools: Students should bring size 10 beading needles, 6lb Fireline, wax, scissors, and a beading surface.

Flat Spiral Bracelet with Pearls and Bicones Joyce Von Lienen Skill Level – Beginner – Class Size – 6 Kit Fee - \$29 – Class Fee - \$40 Total Cost - \$69



In this class you will create a stunning bracelet using seed beads, 6 mm pearls and 4mm crystal bi-cones with a button and loop clasp.

There are three colorways: Patriotic Pearls – red, white and blue; ChristmasPearls – red, white and green; Six color pearls as shown above; Size 11 seed beads in gold or silver

Tools: Size 12 beading needles, 6lb Fireline, wax, scissors, and a beading surface.

Tools required: Bead mat, scissors, 6lb Fireline, size 10/12 beading needles, magnification if required.
